Preserve Guidelines

- Carry out all trash (including human waste and toilet paper)
- Respect private property and stay on preserve
- Please do not disturb nesting birds or wildlife
- Day use only (no camping or overnight parking)
- Swim at your own risk
- Do not remove any archaeological artifacts
- Please leave no trace



- Ticks can carry Lyme and other diseases that are a health risk to people and pets
- Use EPA-registered insect repellents on your skin and clothing
- Inspect yourself, your clothes, and pets for ticks
- Shower and wash clothes soon after being outdoors
- Contact your doctor if a rash develops near a tick bite



- Dogs must be leashed at all times
- Pets must be kept under control at all times
- Do not let dogs disturb wildlife and keep off the mud flats
- Please pick up and carry out all pet waste



- Preserve is open to bow hunting only, permission required
- Wear blaze orange during hunting season
- Hunting is not permitted on Sundays
