Preserve Guidelines

- Carry out all trash (including human and pet waste and toilet paper)
- Keep pets under control
- No camping or overnight parking permitted
- Blueberry fields are privately managed, please do not pick
- Campfires permitted only on the beach—must be smaller than 3 feet
 - Keep all fires below high tide line
 - Leave no fire unattended
 - Completely extinguish all fires
- Stay on established trails
 - Foot traffic only (wheelchairs permitted, use caution)
- Please respect the privacy of preserve neighbors
- Please remember to leave no trace



- Ticks can carry Lyme and other diseases that are a health risk to people and pets
- Use EPA-registered insect repellents on your skin and clothing
- Inspect yourself, your clothes, and pets for ticks
- Shower and wash clothes soon after being outdoors
- Contact your doctor if a rash develops near a tick bite



- Pets must be kept under control at all times
- Please pick up and carry out all pet waste



- This property is open to hunting
- Wear blaze orange during hunting season
- Hunting is not permitted on Sundays
