## Preserve Guidelines

- Carry out all trash (including human, pet waste and toilet paper)
- Campfires permitted-must be smaller than 3 feet
  - Keep all fires below high tide line
  - Do not cut or break tree limbs, dead or alive
  - Leave no fire unattended
  - Completely extinguish all fires
- Camp only at established sites-no camping on beaches
  - Limit stays to 2 nights
  - Groups of 6 or more and commercial users by permission only
- Keep pets under control
- Leased area is private
- Please remember to leave no trace



- Ticks can carry Lyme and other diseases that are a health risk to people and pets
- Use EPA-registered insect repellents on your skin and clothing
- Inspect yourself, your clothes, and pets for ticks
- Shower and wash clothes soon after being outdoors
- Contact your doctor if a rash develops near a tick bite



- Pets must be kept under control at all times
- Please pick up and carry out all pet waste



- This property is open to hunting
- Wear blaze orange during hunting season
- Hunting is not permitted on Sundays
